Personal favorite crops were mentioned – Cajun Gulf Coast garlic, kale, and cabbage were among a few.

Don't forget about your fertilizers and check your pH balance of your soil for the type crops you are interested in growing.

Try your best to get heirloom seeds. Then every year, you can save some seeds from your current garden for future gardens, which is the best for sustainability. And stay away from Monsanto genetically modified seeds.
