INFORMAL CHANNEL 3 NET SCRIPT

Use this script as a guide for the Local CH3 Nets Do not use your FCC call sign on the non-licensed comms (FRS/MURS/CB), use your AmRRON Code Name.

"Good evening (morning/afternoon), this is <your amrron="" code="" name=""> with AmrRON, the American Redoubt Radio Operators Network, and the CH3 project, conducting a PRACTICE communications net on (CB/FRS/MURS) Channel 3. You can learn more about AmrRON by visiting www.AmrRON.com (Alpha, Mike, Romeo, Romeo, Oscar, November.com)"</your>
-Break-
"This is <your amrron="" code="" name=""> conducting an AmrRON PRACTICE communications net on (CB/FRS/MURS) Channel 3. The Net Word of the Week is I say again (phonetically) ". I will now begin check-ins. Anyone wishing to check-in, come now."</your>
- Wait 10 - 15 seconds for a response. If you hear a response, check them into the net and continue asking for check-ins.
"Is there anyone else wishing to check in to the AmRRON CH3 Net?"
<pause -15="" 10="" and="" approximately="" for="" seconds="" wait=""></pause>
- If you hear no other stations coming back to you, then continue:
"Nothing heard. If anyone can copy me and you are unable to check in, you can do so by going to www.amrron.com/checkin (checkin being one word) and let us know you heard the net. This is your AmrRON code name> conducting a PRACTICE communications net on (CB/FRS/MURS) Channel 3, are there any check-ins before I close the net?"
<pause -15="" 10="" and="" any="" are="" check-ins="" if="" respond="" seconds.="" take="" there=""></pause>
"This concludes this AmrRON CH3 emergency communications net. This is, CLEAR."
