

CommStatV2.3 Overview V1.1

CommStatV2.3 adds three features to CommstatV2.

1. "Click to View" StatReps. Selecting a map pin or a StatRep in the main view of CommStat will launch a window that displays the selected StatRep. Additionally if there is a Brevity script in the StatRep, CommStatV2.3 will unpack it and display it in a dedicated window. The StatRep can be displayed and saved as an HTML file.

1. **TO (Recipient):** The CommStat program will autofill and direct your StatRep to the Group you are participating in based on the settings in CommStat.
2. **FROM (Sender):** The CommStat program will autofill your FCC Call Sign based on the settings in JS8.
3. **Scope:** Select the most appropriate for the scale of the report.
4. **StatRep ID:** The StatRep ID will be autofilled by the CommStat program installed on your computer .
5. **My Grid:** The CommStat program will autofill your grid based on the ssettings in JS8.
6. **Map Pin:** Select the most appropriate for the report.
7. **Commercial Power:** Select "Green," "Yellow," or "Red" to reflect status electrical grid in the location you are reporting.

Upgrade CommStatV2.0 to 2.3 Instructions

CommStat2.3 provides upgrade files to upgrade CommStat2.0.

1. Requirements

- a) CommStatone installed and tested
- b) CommStatV2.0 files added to original CommStatone and tested

2. Upgrade CommStat2.0 to 2.3

- a) Download and unzip CommStat2.3 files
- b) Copy and paste the unzipped individual files into the active commstatone directory.
- c) Run commstatone. You are good to go.
